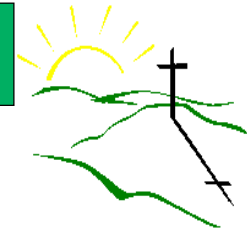
LADS TO LEADERS

September was a rather interesting month for us as Jamaicans and members of the church. Of course the long awaited National elections were held, bearing in mind that the original date was in August but due to Hurricane Dean and the damage that was sustained, it was postponed to September 3. The results were one of our closest in the history of the country with the Jamaica Labor Party (JLP) gaining victory over the People's National Party (PNP) who had been in power since 1989. Bear in mind that while I was in the US earlier this year the new Prime Minister (then Opposition Leader) worshipped at our congregation along with his entourage.

We also spent some time cleaning up after the hurricane and helping a few members back on their feet so to speak. As mentioned in my previous report, there were some damage among members and minor damage to the capping on the church building's roof at the back. So here we were preoccupied with the elections and the cleaning up after the hurricane, at least for the first part of September.

During all these happenings, none of our services were affected and the Lord blessed us greatly with good attendance and brothers and sisters who remained focused on their spiritual lives.

We had a visit from Sis. Christine Rohm from Atlanta, GA staying with my family for couple of days. This was her first time visiting Jamaica, and apart from the temperature, us driving on the left and us speaking another language at times, we really enjoyed her visit. We crammed so much into her short visit, but it was great having her and I appreciate Rex her husband allowing her to be with us for that period. Thanks again Rex and Christine!

The third Sunday we were paid a visit by about twenty members from the Christian Church in Kentucky who were visiting Highgate to help in building some low income houses for people who were practically homeless. They were very pleasant and express there enjoyment of the services.

We continued to follow-up on some of studies from the campaign earlier on this year. At least we able to call some of them and invite that to service which some have been doing. My challenge is to keep at the forefront of the members the need for soul seeking in our daily lives.

My family is doing well....this is all God's doing and to Him be honor and glory.

I want to thank you so much for your prayers and assistance especially during the hurricane and afterwards.
