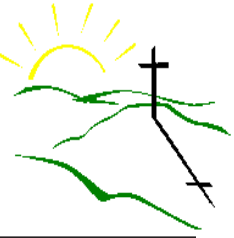

## She Chose Life...

She was very young, dirt poor, uneducated, alone and pregnant. She was engaged to be married, but when her boyfriend found out she was pregnant, and he knew it was not his child, he wanted to end their relationship. If the news of her condition spread throughout her tiny hometown she would become a social outcast. People would stare and whisper as she walked through the market. It would be better for her, and for the child, if she would just have an abortion. What kind of life could she give Him? What would it do to her life if the baby was born? Thankfully, this mother never considered abortion. It would go against everything she knew was right and it would violate God's law (Exodus 20:13.) Mary found herself in the same situation as millions of other women throughout history, except Mary did not become pregnant because of sexual promiscuity. What if Mary had been Pro-Choice? What if Mary belonged to the feminist group National Organization of Women? What if Mary had aborted the baby Jesus? There would be no forgiveness of sins, no hope for the world (Ephesians 2:12-14), no reason to live, no escape from hell. We cannot begin to imagine how catastrophic it would be if that baby had not been born. Too Many young women and girls today do not have the convictions of Mary. They find themselves pregnant and decide they are too young or poor, or needing to finish school, keep their good job, or single and opt to take the life of the one who cannot defend himself. If these people are so "pro-choice", why not give the child a choice as to whether they will live or die? What would those thirty million murdered babies have accomplished had they been give the opportunity to live? Perhaps one of them would have been the one who cured cancer, AIDS, or Multiple Sclerosis. Was there a Nobel Peace Prize winner or Pulitzer Prize winning author in the bunch? Certainly some would have been Christians, maybe even preachers. How many people will not be in heaven because these future soul winners were never given the chance to be born. We will never know. There are only a few times the Bible says God hates something, but one of them is "hands that shed innocent blood" (Proverbs 6:17). America is the greatest place to live on earth, but how "great" is a country that legally and daily murders its own citizens, and innocent, defenseless infants at that? Thank God everyday that Mary was not a pro-choice American, but a God fearing Hebrew.
